|  | The purpose is to tell what people or things are like. The stages are: general statement or definition, series of attributes. |
|  | The purpose is to give information. The stages are: general classification, sequence of facts/description.                    |
|  | The purpose is to show how something can be done. The stages are: statement of goal, list of materials, sequence of steps.    |
|  | Teaching or training; telling or showing how to do something; or what you must do.  |
|  | Telling how to go somewhere or do something.  |
|  | The purpose is to tell why or how. The stages are: statement of phenomenon, sequence of conditions/processes.                 |
