	Funny, amusing, humorous, enjoyable, light-hearted entertainment, such as a show, movie, <i>sitcom</i> , book or cartoon.
	A story, movie or play which deals with human conflict, and usually has a sad ending, with defeat, disaster, death, sorrow, suffering. A common theme is the way serious, unseen forces control the destiny or fate (what happens) of the characters, especially the hero.
	A text, usually a drama, which is both tragic and comic together - so we can laugh at our problems.
	A type of narrative drama or story which is intense, exaggerated and sensationalised. The heroine might be very pure and beautiful, the villain very cruel. The gestures, emotions and plots are overdone, the characters overreact, the music is very emotional.
	An absurd play or drama, usually having an unlikely and improbable plot, and being humorous, ridiculous, and crazy.
	A story or play which makes fun or 'sends-up' things, people, society, politics; to bring out their ridiculous and laughable qualities; using <i>humour, comedy, irony, caricature, parody, sarcasm</i> .
	A humorous imitation, <i>send-up</i> , spoof or caricature. Making something funny or comical by exaggerating.
	A story or poem which has a simple, literal meaning, plus an extra underlying symbolic meaning; and which might have the purpose of teaching a lesson.
	A funny picture, or a humorous story made with drawings.
	A cartoon movie.
