	The purpose is to express your point of view.
	The purpose is to put forward a viewpoint. The stages are: thesis statement, argument points, thesis restatement.
	The purpose is to identify issues and give two sides of an argument. The stages are: statement of issue or viewpoint, arguments for, arguments against, conclusion or thesis statement.
	Similar to <i>review</i> . The purpose is to give views, opinions, judgement, eg. a film or book review. The stages are: context, comments about features, judgement.
	Similar to <i>response</i> . The purpose is to give views, opinions, judgement, eg. a film or book review. The stages are: context, comments about features, judgement.
	A text which gives an opinion, comments, interprets or explains.
	An organised discussion; or a contest with two teams, arguing different sides, for and against.
	A text designed to communicate, draw attention to, praise, perhaps exaggerate, the benefits of products or services; usually in the hope of influencing and persuading the audience to act, use, or buy the products or services.
